MOTION NO. 6756

A MOTION setting the date of public hearing on the feasibility study of the proposed Issaquah Skyport park and recreation service area.

WHEREAS, the City of Issaquah requested King County to form a park and recreation service area for the purpose of acquiring the property in the City of Issaquah known as the Issaquah Skyport and making the necessary improvements thereto for continued operation of the site as a recreational airport facility or for other park and recreational uses on the site, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 7952 requested the executive to submit a feasibility study of the proposal to the King County council, and

WHEREAS, the clerk of the council received the feasibility study of the Issaquah Skyport proposal from the executive on February 24, 1987, and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.68.440 requires that the council hold a public hearing on the feasibility study no more than twenty days after it has been filed with the clerk of the council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

There shall be a public hearing on the feasibility study of the proposed Issaquah Skyport park and recreation service area to be held at the regular council meeting on Monday, March 9, 1987.

The clerk of the council shall advertise this hearing at least five days in advance of the hearing by publication no less than twice in a legal newspaper of general circulation in the county. The published notices of the hearing shall include the following information:

1. Date, time and place of the hearing;
2. Boundaries of the proposed service area as described in the Issaquah Skyport Park and Recreation Service Area feasibility study filed with the Clerk of the Council on February 24, 1987;
