9	of the newly-planned seating area, and

13	completed in time for the first home football game scheduled for
14	September 5, 1987, and
15	WHEREAS, at present there is no guarantee the project will in
16	fact be completed by September 5, 1987, and
17	WHEREAS, should the September 5, 1987, or other successive
18	football games not be able to be played in Husky Stadium, such a
19	prospect could pose potentially serious financial problems for
20	the University of Washington's ability to fund numerous athletic
21	programs, and
22	WHEREAS, such a situation would be unfortunate not only for
23	the university but to the Seattle-King County region;
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
25	A. The county council wishes to express its support and
