MOTION NO. 6782

A MOTION requesting the department of parks,
planning and resources to prepare a community
plan revision study in the Highline Community
Plan area pursuant to K.C.C. 20.12.070C.

WHEREAS, economic development is a high priority of King
County, and

WHEREAS, the economic well being of King County encompasses a
range of options from neighborhood business centers to urban and
rural activity centers, and

WHEREAS, the Highline Community Plan was adopted in 1977
before economic development was declared to be an important
public policy goal by Motion 6012, and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Glendale Way South and 8th
Avenue South is a neighborhood business center which is
underused, vacant or improperly used and should be reviewed, and

WHEREAS, the areas adjacent to this business intersection
should also be reviewed to consider transitional uses to buffer
the established single family residential neighborhood from the
business area, and

WHEREAS, this comprehensive review would assist in the
revitalization of this neighborhood business area which is
another goal of Motion 6012, and

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 20.12.060 through K.C.C. 20.12.080 establish
the procedures and criteria for the consideration of community
plan amendments, and

WHEREAS, the criterion identified in K.C.C. 20.12.070C has
been met because of the importance of economic development, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to prepare a community
plan revision study to further the King County goal of fostering
an expanding, diversified, and revitalized economy;



1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


2 The department of parks, planning, and resources is requested
