MOTION NO. 6785

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$300,000 to support the Issaquah Creek Valley Groundwater Management Plan, Grant File No. 701.

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology is empowered by the Groundwater Management Act to make grants to support plans to protect and preserve groundwater supplies from pollution and depletion, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Issaquah Creek Groundwater Management Plan will develop recommendations for the protection and preservation of the quality and quantity of groundwater resources within the Issaquah Creek Valley management area, and

WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$63,524 as an in-kind contribution of county resources and acknowledges contributions from the City of Issaquah of \$65,760 as an in-kind contribution plus \$36,114 as a cash match and acknowledges contributions from King County Water District No. 82 of \$63,120 as an in-kind contribution and \$36,114 as a cash match in support of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$300,000 to the Department of Ecology for an Issaquah Creek Valley Management Plan on behalf of King County;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

D. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
