MOTION NO. 6787

A MOTION declaring the intention to form a Road Improvement District to improve roads within the plats of Uplake Terrace Addition and Lakemore Terrace #2 and setting a date for a public hearing on the formation.

WHEREAS, petitions have been filed with the King County council requesting the formation of a road improvement district for the improvement of roads within the plats of Uplake Terrace Addition and Lakemore Terrace #2. The petition request that payment of the improvement be made by special assessment payable in twenty (20) equal annual installments, and

WHEREAS, the King County council desires to exclude certain property and improvements described in certain petition, to include other property and improvements which are not described in all of the petitions, to also provide for contribution by the county of part of the cost of the improvements, and to expedite the formation of a road improvement district as so modified, and

WHEREAS, the King County council is authorized by RCW 36.88.030 to initiate formation of a county road improvement district and call for an election to determine whether a road improvement district shall be formed, and

WHEREAS, the King County council desires to regard said petition as advisory and to initiate formation of a road improvement district for the improvement of roads within the plats of Uplake Terrace Addition and Lakemore Terrace #2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the council to establish pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 106" (Hereinafter "RID 106"). It is intended that RID 106 shall include all the territory described as follows:

Addition, thence westerly along the margin of right of way of Northeast Bothell Way to the southwest corner of lot 19 block 2 of said plat, thence northerly along west line of said plat to the northwest corner of lot 10 block 3 plat of Uplake Terrace Addition, thence northeasterly to the northwest corner of said lot 10, thence southerly to the southwest corner of lot 12 block 3, thence easterly to the southeast corner of said lot 12,

thence northwesterly to southeast corner lot 19 block 3, thence northwesterly to the southwest corner of lot 18 block 3, thence northeasterly to the northeastern corner of lot 20 block 3, thence northwesterly to the southwest corner of lot 21 block 3, thence northerly along the west line of said plat to the northwest corner of lot 25 block 3, thence easterly to the southwest corner of lot 28 block 2 Lakemore Terrace No. 2, thence northerly to the northwest corner of said lot 28, thence easterly to the southwest corner of lot 27 block 2 Lakemore Terrace No. 2, thence northerly to the northwest corner of lot 26 block 2 said Plat, thence easterly along the north property lines of lots 26, 25, 24, 23, 21 block 2 to the southwest corner of lot 18 block 2, thence northeasterly along the westerly property line of said lot 18 to the southerly property line of lot 1 block 3 Lakemore Terrace No. 2, thence westerly along said property line to the southwest corner of said lot 1, thence northeasterly to the northwest corner of lot 1, thence southeasterly to the northeast corner of lot 1, thence northwesterly to the southeast corner of lot 1 block 4, thence northwesterly along the southerly property lines of lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 block 4 to the southwest corner of lot 6 block 4, thence northeasterly along the northerly property line of lot 6 to the southwest corner of lot 4 KCSP 677014 AF 7708230569, thence northerly to the northwest corner of lot 1 KCSP 677014, thence easterly along the north property line of said lot 1to the northeast corner of lot 1 said short plat, thence southeasterly to the northwest corner of lot 11 block 5 Lakemore Terrace No. 2, thence easterly to the northeast corner of said lot 11, thence southerly and easterly along the north property lines of lots 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, and 4 block 5 to the northeasterly corner of lot 4 block 5 Lakemore Terrace No. 2. thence southwesterly along the east property line of said lot 4 to the northwesterly corner of lot 6 block 1 Lakemore Terrace No. 2, thence southeasterly along City of Seattle Tolt River pipeline south right of way line to the southeasterly corner of lot 5 block 4 Kenmore Heights Addition, thence southwesterly to the northeasterly corner of a lot defined as in Section 11, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, W.M. west 150 feet of the

following portion Government lot 3 beginning 1,233.31 feet west and S 02-53-27 W 30.02 feet from north ½ corner of section, thence east 264.88 feet to westerly margin of 61st Avenue Northeast, thence southerly along road 126.38 feet, thence west 282 feet to the easterly margin of 60th Avenue Northeast, thence northerly 129.18 feet to beginning also known as tax lot 27; thence southerly along the east property line of said tax lot 27 to the southeast corner of tax lot 27, thence westerly to the southwest corner of tax lot 27, thence southerly and easterly along the easterly and northerly property lines of lots 1 through 13 block 8 Uplake Terrace Addition to the southeast corner of lot 13 block 8, thence southeasterly to the northeast corner of tax lot 78 defined as Section 11, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, W.M. west 90 feet of following -- beginning on westerly margin of county road in government lot 3 N 25-47-47 E 170.76 feet from its intersection with north line of highway, thence northeasterly along said county road 115.83 feet to south margin of Northeast 181st Street, thence S 87-14-47 W along said south margin 326.44 feet, thence S 02-45-13 E 106.54 feet, thence N 87-14-47 E 281.61 feet to beginning less portion east of a line drawn from point 122 feet west of northeast corner to point 76 feet west of southeast corner; thence southerly along east property line to the southeast corner of tax lot 78, thence westerly along south property line to the southwest corner of said tax lot 78, thence southerly along the easterly property lines of lots 1 and 2 block 1 Uplake Terrace Addition to the southeast corner of lot 1 and the true point of beginning.

B. It is the intention of the county council to establish RID 106 for the purposes of improving the following roads:

Northeast 181st Street from 60th Avenue Northeast to 61st Avenue Northeast
Northeast 180th Street from 60th Avenue Northeast westerly to cul-de-sac
58th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 181st Street loop from Northeast 180th
Street to 60th Avenue Northeast

60th Avenue Northeast from Bothell Way to Northeast 185th Street

Northeast 182nd Street from 60th Avenue Northeast to City Limits of Lake

Forest Park

58th Avenue Northeast from Northeast 182nd Street to Northeast 187th Street

57th Avenue Northeast from Northeast 180th Street northerly to cul-de-sac
56th Avenue Northeast from Northeast 187th Street to Northeast 190th
Street

Northeast 183rd Street from 57th Avenue Northeast westerly to cul-de-sac Northeast 184th Street from 57th Avenue Northeast westerly to cul-de-sac It is intended that the improvements shall consist of clearing, grubbing,

grading, draining, ballasting, paving, installing sidewalks, curbs and gutters, and performing any such other work as may be incidental thereto, all in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared by the department of public works.

Said improvements are hereafter sometimes referred to collectively as the "Project."

C. The costs and expenses of accomplishing the project are estimated to be \$894,000. King County shall contribute twenty-five percent of the actual total of such costs and expenses and the remaining seventy-five percent will be borne by and assessed against the property within the proposed RID 106. The actual amount of said costs and expenses will be determined after the project has been completed. "Costs and expenses" of the project are those costs and expenses described in RCW 36.88.300.

It is further the intention of the council that the property owners' share of the actual costs and expenses shall be assessed equally against each lot within the boundary of RID 106.

The actual amount of the final assessment against each parcel of property within RID 106 shall include the actual total of such costs and expenses incurred in completing the project and shall become a lien against each lot of land within RID 106, upon confirmation of the assessment roll by the council. The assessments may be paid in full within 30 days following confirmation of the final assessment roll, or at the option of the owner thereof, in twenty equal, annual installments, together with interest on the diminishing principal at a

rate which is one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%) higher than the net effective interest rate on the bonds which will be sold to pay the cost of the improvements in RID 106.

- D. All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard on the creation of proposed Road Improvement District No. 106 described herein, on the accomplishment of the project described herein, or on the assessment of their property for the costs and expenses of accomplishing the project in the manner described herein, are hereby notified to appear and present their objections or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County council to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, at 9:30 a.m. on the IIII day of May 1987. At such time and place, the council intends to hear such objections and testimony and to act on the intentions set forth herein.
- E. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said public hearing and of the opportunity to cast a vote approving or rejecting the formation of RID 106 by publication and by mailing at the times and in the manner described in RCW 36.88.030. Said notice shall be as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The ballot to be used to cast votes approving or rejecting the formation of RID 106 shall be as set forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

F. The director of the department of public works is hereby directed to submit to the council at, or prior to, the date fixed for said hearing, a diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts, and parcels of land and other; property which will be specially benefited by proposed RID 106, and the estimated amount of the cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by each lot, tract, or parcel of land or other property, and also designating thereon all property which is being purchased under contract from the county.
