8 approximate value of \$190,000, and

10 express gratitude to Mr. and Mrs. Welcome for their
11 extraordinary gift, and

12 WHEREAS, the land is located in an area accessible to
13 schools, public transportation and shopping, and is equipped
14 with public water, electricity and telephone lines, and

16 rural or semi-rural development, and

18 affording a natural refuge for birds and other wildlife, and
