A MOTION authorizing the county executive to apply for grant funds in the approximate amount of \$23,280 to support the expansion of a myocardial infarction surveillance system to include hospitals in the City of Seattle, Grant File No. 714.

WHEREAS, the King County emergency medical services division has started a program to survey the incidence of myocardial infarction in hospitals outside the City of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the effectiveness of this surveillance system in providing critical information relating to improving emergency medical care received by myocardial infarction patients will be improved by including hospitals in the City of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle Medic One Emergency Medical Services Foundation is able to provide, through the University of Washington, approximately \$23,280 to support expansion of a myocardial infarction surveillance system to include hospitals in the City of Seattle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$23,280 to the University of Washington and the Seattle Medic One Emergency Medical Services Foundation to support expansion of a myocardial infarction surveillance program to include hospitals in the City of Seattle;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.

D. The executive is requested to report to the council by the last day of January, 1988 concerning the results gained by expansion of the myocardial infarction surveillance project to include Seattle hospitals.
