2 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to  
3 submit the 1987-89 King County Alcohol and Drug  
4 Abuse Biennial Treatment and Prevention/Early  
Intervention Plans to the Washington State Bureau  
of Alcohol and Substance Abuse.

5 WHEREAS, R.C.W. 69.54.100(3) and 70.96.160 require that plans  
6 be submitted to the Washington State Department of Social and  
7 Health Services outlining services to be provided and anticipated  
8 expenditures and revenues in order to receive financial support  
9 for the King County alcohol and drug treatment and prevention/  
10 early intervention programs and,

11 WHEREAS, the above listed statutes require the approval of such  
12 plans by the county legislative authority prior to submission, and

13 WHEREAS, the 1987-89 King County Alcohol and Drug Abuse  
14 Biennial Treatment Plan has been reviewed and recommended for  
15 approval by the King County Alcoholism and Substance Abuse  
16 Administrative Board at the regular meeting of the Board held on  
17 February 26, 1987, and

18 WHEREAS, the 1987-89 King County Alcohol and Drug Abuse  
19 Biennial Prevention/Early Intervention Plan has been reviewed and  
20 recommended for approval by the King County Prevention Advisory  
21 Committee at a meeting held on March 17, 1987;

22 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit  
24 the 1987-1989 King County Alcohol and Drug Abuse Biennial  
25 Treatment and Prevention/Early Intervention Plans to the  
26 Washington State Bureau of Alcohol and Substance Abuse for their  
27 review and approval.

28 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter  
29 into contracts with the State of Washington Department of Social  
30 and Health Services (DSHS) to provide alcohol/drug treatment and  
31 prevention/early intervention services consistent with the plans.  
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1 C. The executive is requested to report to the council within  
 2 30 days any substantive contract amendments with DSHS beyond the  
 3 scope of the plans herein authorized. Such report shall include  
 4 information concerning additional staff to be hired, revenue,  
 5 anticipated impact on current expense, impacts on county  
 6 facilities, siting of additional leased county facilities, and  
 7 impacts on the county criminal justice system.

8 D. Prior to June 30, 1988 the executive shall provide a  
 9 report to the council concerning progress made on proposed alcohol  
 10 treatment initiatives beyond the scope of the plans herein  
 11 approved.
