A MOTION authorizing the retention of bond counsel in connection with a ballot issue seeking approval of Harborview Medical Center proposed capital improvements, and subsequent issuance of unlimited tax general obligation bonds.

WHEREAS, Harborview Medical Center has prepared a long range capital improvement plan proposing major new construction and funding, and

WHEREAS, funding for such capital improvements will be placed on the ballot for voter approval, and

WHEREAS, the county requires bond counsel services for preparation of the documents related to the ballot issue and in connection with the issuance of bonds to fund such projects should they be approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: Riddell, Williams, Bullitt and Walkinshaw, attorneys at law in Washington, are hereby selected as bond counsel to perform services in connection with placing a ballot issue before the electorate seeking approval of proposed capital improvements at Harborview Medical Center, and subsequent issuance of unlimited tax general obligation bonds to fund such projects should they be approved.
