MOTION NO. 8935

A MOTION authorizing the city of Seattle to divert yard waste from the Cedar Hills landfill.

WHEREAS, King County and the city of Seattle have entered into an interlocal agreement concerning the use of King County solid waste disposal facilities, and

WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement between King County and the city of Seattle requires county approval for diversion of any Seattle waste from King County solid waste disposal facilities, and

WHEREAS, the city of Seattle plans to pursue a yard waste diversion project from August 1, 1987, to November 1, 1987, resulting in approximately 1,600 tons of waste being diverted from the Cedar Hills landfill and has requested the approval of King County for that diversion of waste, and

WHEREAS, King County is supportive of the yard waste diversion project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

King County supports the city of Seattle proposed yard waste diversion project and authorizes the city of Seattle to divert approximately 1,600 tons of waste from Cedar Hills to a composting facility between August and November, 1987, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the interlocal agreement.
