A MOTION relating to an agreement between King County and the City of Redmond to address mitigation of development impacts on the intersection of SR 520 and SR 202.

WHEREAS, King County and the City of Redmond agree that new development within both jurisdictions will significantly impact traffic conditions at the intersection of SR 520 and SR 202, and

WHEREAS, through the attached interlocal agreement, each jurisdiction agrees to follow the methodology described in the agreement when implementing the authority of the City and County under the State Environmental Policy Act and local ordinances to regulate and condition development within their respective jurisdictions to mitigate impacts on the SR 520/SR 202 intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:



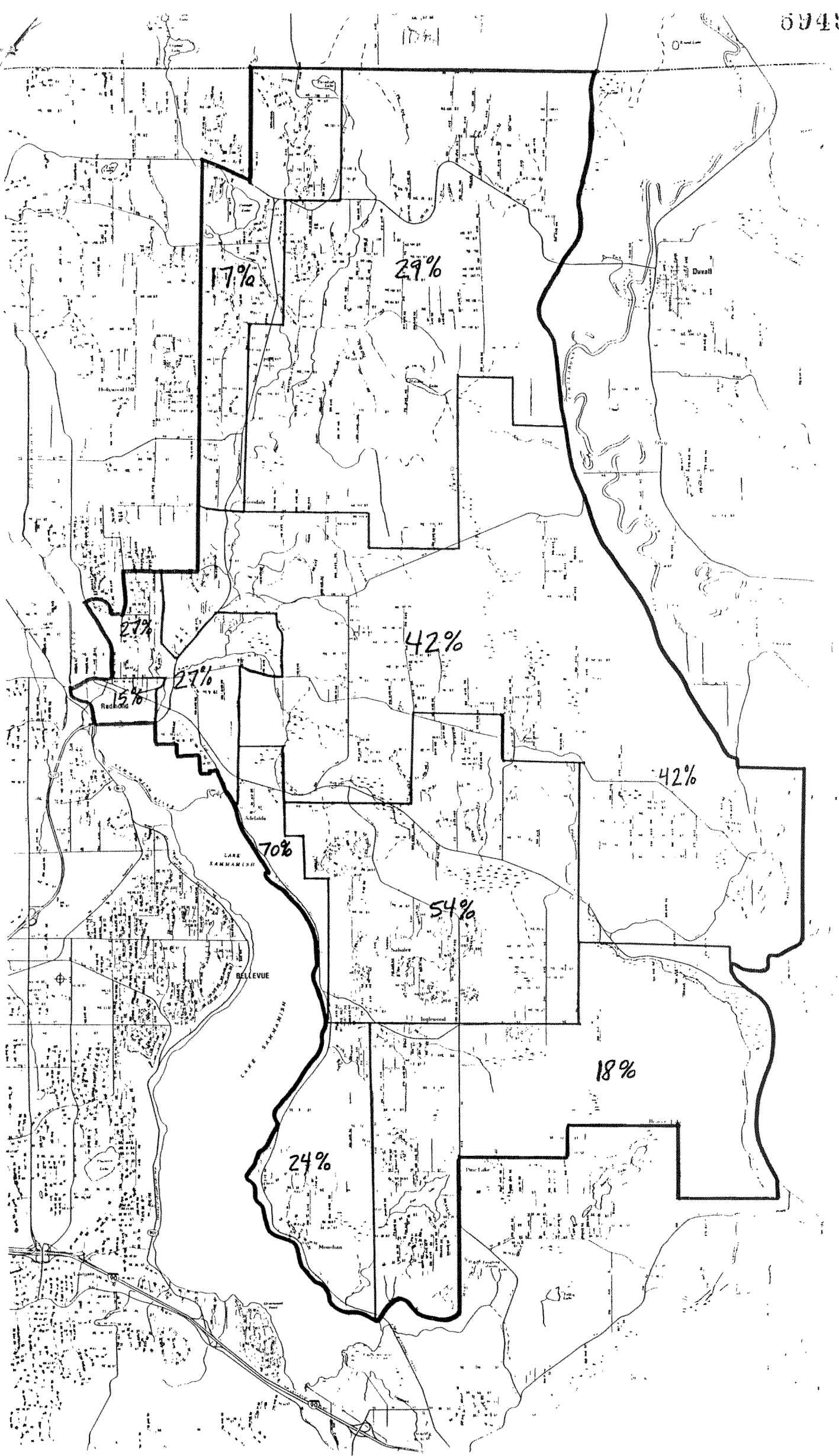


Exhibit A. SR 520/SR 202 Impact Area and Zonal Distribution
