A. The department of stadium administration is directed to waive the normal rental fee for use of the Kingdome on September 9, 1987 for the 1987 United Way Kick-Off and 100th Anniversary Celebration with the understanding that all staffing and miscellaneous costs will be reimbursed to King County under the terms of the standard use agreement.
