WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology has instituted regulations under Chapter 173-100 WAC that provide for a process for long term ground water supply protection, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology has identified the Issaquah Creek Valley as a specific Ground Water Management Area, and placed this area on the Department of Ecology's General Schedule, and

WHEREAS, the Ground Water Management Plan development may require the execution of interlocal agreements with participating agencies, and

WHEREAS, a separate interlocal agreement is required with King County for the Ground Water Management process, and the Interlocal states that King County shall approve the Scope of Work for the Issaquah Creek Valley Ground Water Management Plan, and

WHEREAS, planning and community development and health department staff have reviewed the Scope of Work and recommended approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement (substantially in the form attached) with the City of Issaquah for the purpose of preparing a Ground Water Management Plan.
