A MOTION authorizing the transfer of jurisdiction of property from the department of parks, planning and resources to the department of public safety.

WHEREAS, the property totaling 23,400 square feet was acquired for a potential gravel site by the department of public works in January of 1930, and

WHEREAS, this property was transferred to the parks department in March of 1947, and

WHEREAS, the department of parks, planning, and resources has declared the property surplus to its needs, and

WHEREAS, the site is under the flight path of Seattle-Tacoma
International Airport which greatly limits its potential for other
uses, and

WHEREAS, the department of public safety wishes to construct a Police Indoor Shooting Range for use by its officers and possibly by the officers of the Port of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the proposed range would be housed in a modest sized building which would have little or no impact upon the park and the routine activities performed by both the departments of parks, planning and resource and public works in the abutting Sunset Maintenance Shops;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to transfer the jurisdiction of this land parcel from the department of parks, planning and resources to the department of public safety which is legally described as:

The South 180 feet of the North 425 feet of the East 160 feet of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 16, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M. King County, Washington. Except the East 30 feet for road (18th Avenue South).
