MOTION NO. 7033

A MOTION authorizing the execution of an agreement under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Revised Code of Washington Chapter 39.34

WHEREAS, King County, State of Washington, discharges its responsibility to furnish police service to its citizens by its department of public safety ("the department") under the authority of the county executive, and

WHEREAS, cooperation between law enforcement agencies can provide more efficient operations and mutual benefits, and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Washington needs the services of a police sergeant experienced in both investigation and use of computers in law enforcement, and

WHEREAS, the department is willing to permit Sergeant Robert D. LaMoria to be detailed to the Attorney General's Office for such purpose provided the county is reimbursed for his services and expenses, and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General's Office is willing to reimburse the county for Sergeant LaMoria's services and expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to contract with the State Attorney General's Office for their use of the services of a King County police sergeant on a reimburseable basis, at no net expense to King County.
