A MOTION authorizing the temporary use of construction monies from CIP Project No. 002074 Issaquah District Court to retain the county's option to purchase the proposed replacement site for the project.

WHEREAS, the full costs of the Issaquah District Court CIP Project and the basis for those costs are at present unknown, and WHEREAS, the county may consider the establishment of an Eastside Law, Safety and Justice Center, and

WHEREAS, decisions regarding District Courts districting and the establishment of municipal courts are still pending, and

WHEREAS, retaining the county's option to buy the proposed replacement site for the property will involve no additional cost if the site is eventually purchased;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- \$30,000 in Task 003 Construction of CIP No. 002074 Issaguah District Court will be moved to Task 002 acquisition for the purpose of making option payments of \$10,000 per month on the proposed replacement property for a maximum of three months.
- The project will be substantially completed within 3 years В. of the date of issue of the bonds financing this project.
- The project budget will be reimbursed when the existing site is sold, if the sale allows for construction within the 3 year time-frame.
- If the project does not allow for construction within the 3 year time-frame, the project will be reimbursed on an interim basis from the Current Expense Fund.
