2 A MOTION authorizing the county executive
3 to make a grant application for funds in
4 the approximate amount of \$42,209 to support
a program to create a Coordinated Water Supply
Plan Coordinating Committee.

5 WHEREAS, the Public Water System Coordination Act of 1977,
6 amended, provides for the award of grants to municipalities by
7 the State Department of Social and Health Services, and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Social and Health Services is
9 empowered to make grants to support Coordinated Water Supply
10 Plan Programs, and

11 WHEREAS, the adoption and implementation of four Critical
12 Water Supply Plans in King County will result in a need to
13 revise current King County development review procedures when
14 establishing water services, and

15 WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the
16 approximate amount of \$42,209 as an in-kind contribution in
17 support of the project.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make
20 application for funds in the approximate amount \$42,209 to the
21 Department of Social and Health Services for the creation of a
22 Coordinated Water Supply Plan Coordinating Committee on behalf
23 of King County;

24 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file
25 and execute such application and enter into and execute such
26 contracts as are required by the grantor;

5 assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
