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A MOTION to authorize the granting of a sewer main easement to Water District No. 107 in Council District No. 9: .

WHEREAS, Water District No. 107 has made application for the right to construct, operate, and maintain a sewer main together with all necessary or reasonable appurtenances under and upon the land described herein, and

WHEREAS, this construction of a sewer main on King County land is necessitated by sewer service demands within the plat of Delmar Woods Division No. 5, and
