A MOTION to set the date for a hearing upon the Maintenance Assessment Roll for Road Improvement District No. 110 for street lights on Southeast 426th Street, in King County, Washington.

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance 8203 created King County Road Improvement District No. 110 for maintaining, energizing and operating street lights on Southeast 426th Street from 260th Avenue Southeast to 264th Avenue Southeast: The improvement has been completed and the cost is now known, and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 8203 directed the director of the department of public works to prepare and file with the King County clerk of the council, a maintenance assessment roll for the maintenance assessment to be levied against the property included in Road Improvement District No. 110: The maintenance assessment roll has been prepared and filed with the clerk of the King County council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

- A. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090, the hearing upon the maintenance assessment roll for King County Road Improvement District No. 110 shall be scheduled for March 28, 1988, at 9:30 a.m.
- B. The King County council will sit as a board of equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said roll or any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made de novo as to such body shall appear just and equitable, and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.
- C. The clerk of the King County council is hereby directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to all owners or reputed owners of the property whose name appears thereon by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen days before the date fixed for the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at the address of such owner as shown on the tax rolls of the King County office of finance; in addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two (2) times in a

newspaper of general circulation in the county if the paper is published weekly or five (5) times if the paper is published daily. Such notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file same with the clerk of the council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
