MOTION NO. 7118

A MOTION declaring the existence of an emergency in the King County Jail requiring the immediate implementation of capital construction projects in the facility and waiving the requirements of competitive bidding for the work.

WHEREAS, The King County council appropriated funds to remodel the West Wing, remodel the property room, construct a secure courtroom and relocate administrative office space from the courthouse to the jail, and

WHEREAS, the completion of these projects will help alleviate crowded conditions in the King County Jail and facilitate jail and court operations, and

WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for formal competitive bidding of the construction contracts necessary for this work must be waived to prevent delay in beginning construction, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4551 and K.C.C. 4.16.050 permit waiver of the requirements of public bidding by motion of the King County council upon declaration of an emergency and where the public interest or property of King County would suffer material injury or damage by delay;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County council declares that an emergency exists in the King County Jail whereby the public interest will suffer material injury and damage if necessary work to complete appropriated remodeling projects in the facility is delayed.

B. The ordinary requirements for formal competitive bidding of the construction contracts necessary for such work are hereby waived.

Provided that:

All Minority Women's Business Enterprise requirements will be met.

1 Provided further that:


2 Whenever possible, a minimum of five contractors or vendors will

4 Provided further that:


5 An additional 10% contingency will be held in reserve from each
