MOTION NO. 7131

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$380,260, to support a Release Watch program, Grant File No. 804.

WHEREAS, the National Association of State Alcohol and Drug Abuse Directors is empowered to make grants in support of demonstration programs to determine appropriate intervention strategies for selected populations of drug involved offenders, and

WHEREAS, the establishment of pretrial release conditions for drug involved offenders is a means of controlling the population of the jail, and

WHEREAS, the Release Watch program will assist the county in evaluating the effectiveness of various conditions of pretrial release, and

WHEREAS, the King County prosecuting attorney and the King County Superior Court have pledged their support and participation in the Release Watch program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$380,260 to the National Association of State Alcohol and Drug Abuse Directors on behalf of King County.

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.


C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.

1 D. The King County executive shall evaluate the  
2 effectiveness of the project by comparing the cost to the  
3 benefits. Benefits of the project shall include the impact of  
4 the project upon the population of the jail.


5 E. The National Association of State Alcohol and Drug Abuse  
6 Directors and the Department of Justice are hereby assured of  
7 full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
