6 MOTION NO. 7139

7 A MOTION authorizing the King County
8 Executive to negotiate the participation
9 by King County in establishing a world
class aquatics facility which meets the
specifications for the Goodwill Games.

10 WHEREAS, the county believes that it is in the interest of the
11 citizens of King County as well as to the region for King County
12 to participate in the establishment of a world class aquatics
13 facility that can be used for the Goodwill Games as well as other
14 swimming events, and

15 WHEREAS, the establishment of a world class swimming facility
16 would establish the King County region as a world center for
17 international swimming, and

18 WHEREAS, the council recognizes the opportunity to build such
19 a facility exists only in conjunction with a major event such as
20 the Goodwill Games, and

21 WHEREAS, the county's financial participation coupled with
22 financial participation of other sources including the Goodwill
23 Games could provide for a major public resource for the region
24 which is funded only in part by public funds;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 The King County executive is authorized to negotiate with the
27 Seattle Goodwill organizing committee the participation by King
28 County in establishing a world class aquatics facility in King
29 County which meets the specifications of the Goodwill Games;

1 PROVIDED, that any agreement shall require King County council
2 approval prior to execution, and

3 FURTHER PROVIDED, that as soon as possible the King County
4 executive, with assistance of the office of prosecuting attorney,
5 shall report to the county council his recommendation for the best
6 arrangement for constructing the pool facility to ensure that it
7 is constructed to meet all specifications including Section 504
8 handicap access requirements of federal law on time and within a
9 specific budget available from all sources including King County.
