A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to set aside property located adjacent to the Marymoor Velodrome for a new velodrome complex.

WHEREAS, the Marymoor Velodrome has served to introduce the sport of bicycle racing to the citizens of King County, Puget Sound and the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the Marymoor Velodrome has played host to two United States National Cycling Championships, three Olympic Trials qualifying events, and many nationally significant, competitions, and

WHEREAS, the design of the track, while appropriate for its current type and level of use, is not consistent with the demands of international competition, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Chamber of Commerce has initiated efforts to design and build a new international-class velodrome as an integral element of a proposed National Bicycle Center, and

WHEREAS, such competitions would represent a tremendous asset to the Eastside community and King County in general, in terms of tourism, publicity, and standing in the U.S. amateur athletic community, and

WHEREAS, this new facility, to be located adjacent to the existing Marymoor Velodrome, would create a complex unique in the United States able to meet the education, training, and competitive needs of bicyclists of all skill and athletic abilities, and

WHEREAS, the county, through a commitment to preserving the best site for this facility, can encourage private sector donations to this project;
