WHEREAS, the Tahoma/Raven Heights communities plan, enacted by ordinance no. 6986, identifies the need for and proposes the construction of a neighborhood collector street, to serve an area designated for residential development between SR 516 (S.E. 272nd Street, also known as the Kent-Kangley Road) on the south, and SR 18 on the north, between the existing residential developments known as Timberline to the west and Cedar Downs to the east, and

WHEREAS, there have been submitted to King County proposed subdivisions of portions of this area, for which construction of a neighborhood collector street is required in order to lessen congestion in the streets and highways and promote safe and convenient travel by the public, as required by the state subdivision act (RCW chapter 58.17);
