WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, through the Centers for Disease Control, has requested proposals for investigation into alternative tuberculosis treatment methods, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County department of public health is engaged in the treatment of tuberculosis and has the necessary abilities to undertake an investigation into alternative forms of therapy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$201,636 to the Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control, for a Tuberculosis Treatment program on behalf of King County;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
