A MOTION calling for the District Court Districting Committee to reconvene in accordance with RCW 3.38 to consider an amended District Court Plan to provide for unified District Courts.

WHEREAS, RCW 3.38 specifies the procedures to establish or amend a District Court plan, and

WHEREAS, the council believes that a unified system of courts, with continued decentralized community based facilities and elected judges, is the best means to provide a quality system of justice at the least cost to the taxpayer, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to consider amendments to the District Court plan and other measures to implement a unified system of District Courts, and

WHEREAS, representatives of the District Court judges have agreed to work in cooperation to examine the administrative and judicial procedures necessary to implement an orderly and thoughtful transition to a unified system, and

WHEREAS, reconvening the Districting Committee would provide greater opportunity to consider the approaches to establishing a unified District Court system and meeting the needs of the cities who contract with the District Court system;
