PROPOSED NO. 88 - 207

MOTION NO. 7180

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to enter into an agreement with the City of Kirkland to reaffirm the county's participation in funding a share of the local match for the 116th Avenue Northeast reconstruction project.

WHEREAS, a June 1984 agreement between King County (the county) and the City of Kirkland (the city) stated that the county would provide a share of the local matching funds for the 116th Avenue Northeast construction project, and

WHEREAS, the agreement further designated the county as lead agency on the project through construction, and

WHEREAS, the city and county have been discussing a change in the division of responsibility for the project, and

WHEREAS, the city and county agreed in the 1984 agreement that in the event annexation occurred resulting in the project being within the Kirkland city limits, there would continue to be a share of the local match, and

WHEREAS, the voters of lower Juanita voted to be annexed by the City of Kirkland on November 3, 1987, and

WHEREAS, on January 1, 1988, 116th Avenue Northeast became part of the City of Kirkland;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Kirkland to reaffirm commitment to the portion of the 1984 agreement which outlines the amount of local match to be funded by King County and the City of Kirkland and renegotiate the terms designating lead agency responsibility for the project.
