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A MOTION relating to the Community Development Block Grant Program adopting the 1989 King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan, including the administrative setaside, and the 1989 Community Development Block Grant Local Program Policies for the Pass-through Cities funds and for the County and Small Cities funds, including the King County regional earmarks for 1989.

WHEREAS, King County is a member of the King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium, and

WHEREAS, King County as the official applicant is responsible to the federal government for all activities undertaken in the King County Consortium with Community Development Block Grant funds, and

WHEREAS, the 1988-1990 Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the governing body of King County and participating incorporated jurisdictions within King County sets forth an arrangement for planning the distribution of Community Development Block Grant funds, including the administrative setaside, and

WHEREAS, federal Community Development Block Grant legislation requires King County to adopt an annual community development plan to guide the use of Community Development Block Grant funds and identify community development and housing needs, and

WHEREAS, the 1989 King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan (hereinafter referred to as the 1989 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan) meets the federal Community Development Block Grant requirements for an annual plan for the year January 1, 1988 to December 31, 1989, and

WHEREAS, Consortium members participated in the development of the 1989 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan through review and comment, and

WHEREAS, the Consortium's Joint Policy Committee approved the 1989 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan, including the administrative setaside, and

WHEREAS, the formula for the distribution of county CDBG funds among three designated regions of unincorporated King County (northeast, southeast, and southwest) adopted in Motion 5746 has now been updated to include the

1 small incorporated cities which now participate in the County and Small
 2 Cities fund, and is now incorporated in the 1989 CDBG Local Program Policies
 3 for the County and Small Cities funds, and

4 WHEREAS, the King County executive has submitted the 1989 CDBG Consortium
 5 Policy Plan, including the administrative setaside, and the 1989 CDBG Local
 6 Program Policies for the Pass-through Cities funds and for the County and
 7 Small Cities fund, including the regional earmarks;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

9 A. The attached 1989 King County Community Development Block Grant
 10 Consortium Policy Plan including the administrative setaside, and the 1989
 11 Community Development Grant Local Program Policies for the Pass-through
 12 Cities and for the County and Small Cities fund, including the regional
 13 earmarks, are hereby adopted to replace the 1988 King County Community Devel-
 14 opment Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan and the 1988 King County Community
 15 Development Block Grant Local Program Policies and to govern the planning
 16 process and development of the 1989 Community Development Block Grant Program.


17 B. All eligible applications shall be given consideration.
