A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with the Cedar River Water and Sewer District for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water system in Council Districts No. 6 and 9.

WHEREAS, the Cedar River Water and Sewer District has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate, and maintain a water system in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010 for the plat of Maplewood Estates, and

A. The granting of a franchise to the Cedar River Water and Sewer District to construct, operate and maintain a water system within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the water system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the Cedar River Water and Sewer District and shall expire on May 5, 2011, concurrent with their Franchise No. 6521. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.
