5 A MOTION related to the King County
6 Park System: waiving competitive
7 bidding and M/WBE requirements for
8 asbestos removal at Evergreen and
9 Shoreline Pools.

10 WHEREAS, the King County safety office conducted an asbestos
11 survey that resulted in an appropriation of funds for asbestos
12 removal in 1988, and

13 WHEREAS, subsequent detailed design by the natural resources
14 and parks division uncovered the existence of previously
15 unreported asbestos at Evergreen Pool and more extensive asbestos
16 at Shoreline Pool than previously reported, and

17 WHEREAS, the natural resources and parks division also
18 received funding for other work at these sites including roof
19 repairs, ceiling repairs and replacement of pool liners which
20 would require future pool closures to accomplish, and

21 WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to accomplish all of
22 this work at one time thereby minimizing the number and length of
23 pool closures, and

24 WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for competitive bidding
25 and M/WBE participation in construction contracts per K.C.C. 4.18
26 must be waived for the highly specialized asbestos removal
27 portion of this project in order to prevent delays in beginning
28 such work:

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

30 A. The county council declares that an emergency exists in
31 King County whereby the public interest would suffer material
32 injury if necessary rehabilitation work at the Evergreen and
33 Shoreline Pools is delayed.


