MOTION NO. 7213

A MOTION recognizing and congratulating Cherry Crest and Redmond Elementary Schools for being selected as two of 265 schools in the United States to receive awards for educational excellence through the federal Elementary National Recognition Program.

WHEREAS, the selection process carefully examined detailed descriptions of programs, policies and practices provided by the schools and included site visits that consisted of interviews with students, parents, teachers, support staff and district administrators, and

WHEREAS, the schools were judged on philosophy and goals, organization, leadership, curriculum, instruction, student scores, character development, climate, community relations and the effort to maintain high-quality programs, especially in math and science, and

WHEREAS, Cherry Crest Elementary in the Bellevue School District and Redmond Elementary in the Lake Washington School District scored well in all these categories and has, by its selection as an outstanding elementary school, brought honor and recognition to our community;

The King County council commends the students, parents, faculty and administrators of Cherry Crest Elementary and Redmond Elementary for their cooperative efforts in achieving this distinguished award, which is an inspiration to all other schools.
