A MOTION related to the King County
Parks and Open Space System;
authorizing the acquisition of land in
the vicinity of Cougar Mountain, Tolt
MacDonald.

WHEREAS, in adopting the 1988 budget the county council
required the county executive to review and make a recommendation
in the context of the Open Space Plan on the acquisition for park
and open space purposes of two properties; one on Cougar Mountain
and one adjacent to the King County Tolt MacDonald Park, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Open Space Plan includes a detailed
review of these acquisitions, and

WHEREAS, public opinion surveys conducted as a part of the
Open Space Plan ranked the preservation of wildlife habitat and
public access to water as the two most important goals of King
County Open Space Plan, and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the Cougar Mountain and the Tolt
MacDonald properties will advance the preservation of wildlife
habitat, public access to water, potential for regional trails,
existence of wetlands and also are valuable as community
separators;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Funds appropriated in the 1988 budget for the acquisition of
land in the vicinity of Cougar Mountain and Tolt MacDonald Parks
are hereby released.
