MOTION NO. 7225

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with the City of Seattle, City Light Department for a franchise to construct, operate, repair and maintain electric transmission lines, poles and appurtenances in Council Districts 1 and 4.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle, City Light Department has filed an application to renew a franchise to construct, operate, repair and maintain an electrical transmission system to serve residential and commercial areas in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the relevant county executive departments for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive and the department of public works have recommended approval of the franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to the City of Seattle, City Light Department to construct, operate, repair and maintain an electrical transmission system within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the electrical system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the City of Seattle, City Light Department, to expire on April 29, 1993, concurrent with their Franchise No. 595. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.

B. If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
