A MOTION urging the executive to provide cities with a 60-day grace period in which to sign interlocal agreements with King County for solid waste management.

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 10.08.130 prohibits the use of King County disposal facilities by cities which have not executed interlocal agreements with the county by June 30, 1988, and

WHEREAS, interlocal agreements with cities using King County disposal facilities are essential for solid waste management planning, and

WHEREAS, a model interlocal agreement for solid waste management was developed by a joint committee of cities and county representatives and presented in 1987 to each city in the county which did not already have such an agreement, and

WHEREAS, King County has extended the deadline for execution of these agreements by six months past the date originally adopted in August, 1986 in Ordinance 7708 and 7737, and

WHEREAS, as of June 30, 1988 some cities have not signed interlocal agreements with King County but have indicated a willingness to proceed with execution of these agreements based upon language negotiated over the past few months, and

WHEREAS, it may be in the best interests of King County and those cities which have indicated a willingness to enter into interlocal agreements with the county to allow a brief extension of the deadline for execution of the agreements, and

WHEREAS, other cities have not signed interlocal agreements with King County and have not presented the county with alternative language or any means of negotiation toward mutually satisfactory agreements, and

WHEREAS, it is not in the best interests of King County to continue to defer execution of interlocal agreements indefinitely;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The executive is urged to grant a sixty day grace period beyond the deadline stated in K.C.C. 10.08.130 for execution of interlocal agreements between King County and cities which plan to use King County solid waste disposal facilities, during which there would be no penalties imposed for use of county disposal facilities without an agreement, in order to allow those cities which intend to enter into agreements with the county to proceed to do so; provided that following the 60-day grace period, penalties for violation of K.C.C. 10.08.130 and any special fees, which are presently being considered and may be enacted, are vigorously enforced.
