8 WHEREAS, the King County Council passed Ordinance No. 8350
9 establishing a merit selection process to fill vacancies in
10 district court in King County on December 14, 1987, and

11 WHEREAS, the appointment of district court judge Joe Wesley
12 to the King County superior court created a vacancy in the
13 Seattle district court, and

14 WHEREAS, the King County Council did not eliminate the
15 position in the redistricting amendments passed in April 1988, and

16 WHEREAS, the bar association has spent hundreds of hours of
17 its members' time in reviewing and evaluating the candidates
18 based on merit, and

19 WHEREAS, the King County council has recently received a list
20 of eight candidates given highest rating by one or more of the
21 qualified bar associations pursuant to Ordinance No 8350, and

22 WHEREAS, the council has the responsibility to ensure the
23 successful implementation of its newly established merit
24 selection process, and

25 WHEREAS, the King County council shall take the necessary
26 actions to ensure the appointment of a new Seattle district court
27 judge from the merit list on or before July 5, 1988;
