A MOTION requesting the County Executive to acquire property owned by Fire District No. 39 and to study pedestrian traffic problems on South 312th Street.

WHEREAS, King County desires to expand the Steel Lake Park facilities by moving its equipment storage to another location, and

WHEREAS, Fire District No. 39 is selling property located adjacent to the park, and

WHEREAS, this land would be suitable for the desired park facility expansion, and

WHEREAS, the Fire District No. 39 commissioners are willing to sell the property to King County, and

WHEREAS, Steel Lake Park is bisected by South 312th Street which increases the possibility of traffic hazards as park users cross the road, and

WHEREAS, future commercial development will increase the traffic and hazards to park users on this portion of South 312th Street;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The natural resources and parks division is requested to initiate the acquisition of property owned by Fire District No. 39, Station 4, located at 31132 28th Avenue South with funds from the Conservation Futures Tax or any other suitable revenue source in the 1989 Capital Budget preparation.

B. The department of public works is requested to study the pedestrian traffic problems for the portion of South 312th Street between 24th Avenue South and 28th Avenue South and to report recommendations to the council by October 1, 1988.
