MOTION NO. 7252

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with Woodinville Water District for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water system in Council Districts No. 1 and 3.

WHEREAS, Woodinville Water District has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate, and maintain a water system in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the District's comprehensive plan was approved on April 29, 1985 by King County Council Ordinance No. 7197, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the county executive for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has recommended approval of the franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to Woodinville Water district to construct, operate and maintain a water system within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the water system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the Woodinville Water District and shall expire on March 18, 2010, concurrent with its Franchise No. 6218. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.

B. If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
