A MOTION establishing a community corrections board in King County, sanctioning the appropriate members of the Jail Committee Work Group, as specified by RCW 72.09.300, as members of the community corrections board.

WHEREAS, RCW 72.09.300 authorizes counties to establish a community corrections board, and

WHEREAS, RCW 72.02.300 directs the community corrections board to develop a community corrections plan describing existing correctional resources, goals, objectives, needs, and problems for local and state correctional services in the county, and ways to share administrative costs between local and state governments, and

WHEREAS, the development of a community corrections plan would be beneficial to provide alternatives to alleviate jail overcrowding in King County, and

WHEREAS, RCW 72.09.300 specifies that the community corrections board shall consist of four members appointed by the county legislative authority including two members from the private sector, one member appointed by the secretary of corrections, the county prosecutor and sheriff or their designees, a judge of the superior court selected by the superior court judges, and a judge of the district court selected by the district court judges, and

WHEREAS, the membership of the jail committee work group already includes a member appointed by the secretary of corrections, a designee of the county prosecutor and sheriff, a superior court judge and a district court judge;

A. The King County council hereby establishes a community corrections board and sanctions the appropriate membership of the jail committee work group as specified in RCW 72.09.300 as members of the community corrections board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

B. The King County council shall appoint the remaining four members of the community corrections board, including two members from the private sector.
