A MOTION related to the King County park system; approving the master plan and the CIP budget for Green River Trail pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance No. 7341.

WHEREAS, \$1.2 million dollars in bonds were authorized and appropriated for the master planning and development of the Green River Trail, and

WHEREAS, in appropriating these funds, the council directed the natural resources and parks division to develop a master plan and project budget for council review, and

WHEREAS, the natural resources and parks division subsequently retained a design consultant who prepared a site analysis and alternatives which resulted in the final preferred site plan, and

WHEREAS, the division held public meetings, in Kent, Tukwila, and Auburn where the public was presented with various trail alignment options and later with the proposed final alignment, and concurred with the preferred trail alignment and development plan, and

WHEREAS, the natural resources and parks division has coordinated development plans with the cities of Kent, Auburn, Tukwila and Renton as well as with Seattle City Light, Washington State Department of Transportation, Metro, the county surface water management division, and the county roads division;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance No. 7341, the attached master plan for the Green River Trail, with the attached trail route amendment, is hereby adopted.

Funds reserved in Ordinance No. 7341 are hereby released for acquisition and development pursuant to the master plan with acquisition as described in phase 1b to receive top priority.

PROVIDED THAT, when barriers are required the use of natural vegetation barriers is maximized unless cost or other practical considerations prohibit this approach. If permanent cyclone fencing is recommended for any portion of the first phase of development, approval by the council is required.

PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT the executive obtain council approval of policy regarding county funding of trail acquisition and development within incorporated areas before expenditures within these areas are made.
