4 MOTION NO. 7273

5 A MOTION related to the King County park
6 system; approving the master plan and the
7 CIP budget for Green River Trail pursuant
to the requirements of Ordinance No. 7341.

8 WHEREAS, \$1.2 million dollars in bonds were authorized and
9 appropriated for the master planning and development of the Green
10 River Trail, and

11 WHEREAS, in appropriating these funds, the council directed
12 the natural resources and parks division to develop a master plan
13 and project budget for council review, and

14 WHEREAS, the natural resources and parks division subsequently
15 retained a design consultant who prepared a site analysis and
16 alternatives which resulted in the final preferred site plan, and

17 WHEREAS, the division held public meetings, in Kent, Tukwila,
18 and Auburn where the public was presented with various trail
19 alignment options and later with the proposed final alignment, and
20 concurred with the preferred trail alignment and development plan,
21 and

22 WHEREAS, the natural resources and parks division has
23 coordinated development plans with the cities of Kent, Auburn,
24 Tukwila and Renton as well as with Seattle City Light, Washington
25 State Department of Transportation, Metro, the county surface
26 water management division, and the county roads division;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

28 Pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance No. 7341, the
29 attached master plan for the Green River Trail, with the attached
30 trail route amendment, is hereby adopted.

1 Funds reserved in Ordinance No. 7341 are hereby released for
2 acquisition and development pursuant to the master plan with
3 acquisition as described in phase 1b to receive top priority.

4 PROVIDED THAT, when barriers are required the use of natural
5 vegetation barriers is maximized unless cost or other practical
6 considerations prohibit this approach. If permanent cyclone
7 fencing is recommended for any portion of the first phase of
8 development, approval by the council is required.

9 PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT the executive obtain council approval
10 of policy regarding county funding of trail acquisition and
11 development within incorporated areas before expenditures within
12 these areas are made.
