WHEREAS, Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) continues to grow as a public health problem in King County, and

WHEREAS, the social and financial impact of the AIDS epidemic in King County will be substantial in the coming years, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County health department has assumed a lead administrative role in King County for coordinating public policies and programs designed to deal with the AIDS epidemic regionally, and

WHEREAS, the health department has identified a need for supplemental funds to enable gaps in services to persons with AIDS to be remedied;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$742,099 to the Public Health Services, Health Resources and Services Administration for supplementation of the AIDS Services and Support grant program on behalf of King County;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
- C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
