6 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to transmit a  
7 supplemental grant application to the Health Resources and  
8 Services Administration for supplementation of the AIDS  
9 Services and Support grant program on behalf of King County.

10 WHEREAS, Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) continues to grow as a  
11 public health problem in King County, and

12 WHEREAS, the social and financial impact of the AIDS epidemic in King County  
13 will be substantial in the coming years, and

14 WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County health department has assumed a lead admin-  
15 istrative role in King County for coordinating public policies and programs  
16 designed to deal with the AIDS epidemic regionally, and

17 WHEREAS, the health department has identified a need for supplemental funds  
18 to enable gaps in services to persons with AIDS to be remedied;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for  
21 funds in the approximate amount of \$742,099 to the Public Health Services,  
22 Health Resources and Services Administration for supplementation of the AIDS  
23 Services and Support grant program on behalf of King County;

24 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such  
25 application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the  
26 grantor;

27 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute  
28 such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.

D. The Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Service is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
