- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,088,806 to the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation for a program to prevent the spread of AIDS through behavior modification on behalf of King County;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
- C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project; and
