A MOTION supporting the project recommendations of the King County Executive for Transitional Housing Matching Funds for Families and authorizing the executive to enter into contracts with agencies to fund transitional housing projects.

WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes that transitional housing is needed to stabilize the lives of homeless families and teen mothers, and

WHEREAS, housing the homeless is a pressing community and human services need, and

WHEREAS, transitional housing is critical to homeless families in obtaining services and skills to become self-sufficient, and

WHEREAS, the supply of transitional housing in King County to assist homeless families is inadequate, and

WHEREAS, matching funds are necessary to leverage state and federal resources for the development of transitional housing, and

WHEREAS, the King County council allocated \$65,000 of its 1988 health and human services appropriation for transitional housing matching funds for families, and

WHEREAS, a request for proposal process was conducted in September 1988, and

WHEREAS, proposals were received and evaluated based on program policies and guidelines;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The recommendations of the King County executive for transitional housing projects are supported.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The King County executive is authorized to enter into contracts with agencies to provide transitional housing matching funds for families for recommended projects.
