A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$110,000 to support in part the preparation of an update of the King

County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, Grant File No. 833.

WHEREAS, King County is required by R.C.W. 70.95 to prepare a coordinated comprehensive solid waste management plan which will guide development of solid waste management plans and programs in King County and will include the estimated long-range needs for solid waste facilities projected twenty years into the future, and

WHEREAS, The Hazardous Waste Cleanup Act provides for the award of grants by the Department of Ecology for solid waste planning, and \$110,000 of the available grant funds have been set aside for use by class AA counties, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has committed to preparing a solid waste management plan for the City of Seattle to be integrated with the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan (KCSWMP) in accordance with R.C.W. 70.95.080(1), and

WHEREAS, King County shall allocate \$38,500 of this grant to the City of Seattle for the city to prepare a solid waste plan, and

WHEREAS, the council of King County recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$71,500 in cash and/or direct services as a match in support of the project, and

WHEREAS, the \$71,500 match for the grant shall be met through 1988 appropriated expenditure authority, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has an obligation to provide the amount of \$38,500 in cash and/or direct services as a match support of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$110,000 to the Department of Ecology for the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan on behalf of King County,
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application, and to allocate such funds to the City of Seattle,
- C. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured of full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
