A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to submit an application for funding to the U. S. Department of Agriculture Farmers Home Administration for the Housing Preservation Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the federal government through the enactment of the Housing and Urban-Rural Recovery Act of 1983 will make Housing Preservation Grant Program funds available to local governments to operate housing rehabilitation programs in rural areas, and

WHEREAS, the federal government through the regulations for the Housing Preservation Grant Program requires King County to submit an application for the funds to the U. S. Department of Agriculture Farmers Home Administration, and


WHEREAS, it has been determined by review of data from the 1980 U. S. Census, the King County 1981 housing condition survey, and available data from other King County housing rehabilitation programs that thousands of low- and very low-income homeowners reside in rural areas of King County who require urgent housing repairs to protect life and property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to submit the necessary program applications to the U. S. Department of Agriculture Farmers Home Administration for the Housing Preservation Grant Program.
