WHEREAS, the remaining parcels will be offered for sale at public oral auction at the minimum acceptable offers being those shown below or traded for other property desired by King County, and

WHEREAS, when it would be in the best interests of King County, the fee-owned properties may be sold on contract with 20 percent down and the balance on a 10 year contract at 12 percent interest, and

WHEREAS, the King County executive has recommended that these parcels be declared surplus and either sold or traded, whichever manner is in the best interest of King County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The properties are hereby declared suplus and the King County executive is authorized to dispose of the surplus properties described as follows by either sale or trade and to execute the necessary documents,

PROVIDED THAT:

prior to the sale or trade date for lots 45, 46 and 47, Grotto Addition, the King County executive shall forward to the council a current letter of opinion as to market value which shall indicate an appraisal date no earlier than six months from the proposed date of sale or trade, and a fair market value derived within that time period. The council's approval of the sale or trade of lots 45, 46 and 47, Grotto Addition described as follows is contingent upon the receipt of a current letter of opinion as to market value, as stipulated.
