5 A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant
6 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$3,585,378
7 to support a study of the range of methadone services, Grant
File No. 904.

8 WHEREAS, intravenous drug abuse is a significant factor in the transmission
9 of the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and the incidence of the Acquired
10 Immune Deficiency Syndrom (AIDS), and

11 WHEREAS, existing treatment programs for drug abusers are based on histori-
12 cal practices and are not supported by a major body of research data, and the
13 understanding of the relative merits of different mixtures of treatment services
14 is therefore incomplete, and

15 WHEREAS, the study of the range of methadone services will enable collection
16 of data regarding the results of different levels of services provided to indi-
17 viduals who are receiving methadone maintenance treatments, and enable evalua-
18 tion of the results of the different treatments, and

19 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, through the National
20 Institute on Drug Abuse, is empowered to make grants in support of programs
21 which could improve the effectiveness of drug abuse treatment services and help
22 to reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS in the country;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 A. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for
25 funds in the approximate amount of \$3,585,378 to the Department of Health and
26 Human Services, National Institute on Drug Abuse, for a study of the range of
27 methadone services on behalf of King County;

28 B. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such
29 application and to enter into an execute such contracts as are required by the
30 grantor;



D. The Department of Health and Human Services, National Institute on Drug Abuse is hereby assured of full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.


