## MOTION NO. 7521

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$426,289 for development of a Maternal and Child Health Nursing Expert System, Grant File No. 908.

WHEREAS, the need for public health nursing services has become greater and more complex in recent years through the spread of HIV infection, drug addiction, and homelessness among patients in need of maternal and child health services, and

WHEREAS, existing methods of dealing with patient assessment, diagnoses and care are time consuming, and are in need of improvement to ensure compliance with recognized standards of nursing care and to facilitate evaluation of the results of the care provided to the patients, and

WHEREAS, the methods of dealing with patient assessment, diagnoses and care can be improved through the development of a computer based expert system to provide a Maternal Child Health Nursing Expert System to assist nurses and supervisory staff in the delivery and management of health care, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, through the Bureau of Maternal and Child Health and Resources Development, is empowered to make grants in support of programs that could improve the quality of care and management of maternal and child care programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$426,289 to the Department of Health and Human Services, Bureau of Maternal and Child Health and Resources Development for the development of a Maternal and Child Health Nursing Expert System on behalf of King County;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
