A MOTION accepting a grant award from the Department of Social and Health Services for a High Risk Youth Support Project.

WHEREAS, The Federal Anti-Drug act of 1986 (P.L. 99-570) supports the provision of services to youths exposed to risks of becoming involved with substance abuse, and the Governor of the State of Washington and the Department of Social and Health Services have requested proposals for services to youths at risk of substance abuse, and

WHEREAS, the division of alcoholism and substance abuse has submitted a proposal and received an award of \$5,000 to provide youths with learning disabilities with a program of emotional support and skills training;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


A. The King County executive is authorized to apply for a \$5,000 grant from the state for a High Risk Youth Support Project.

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to accept an award of \$5,000 from the Department of Social and Health Services for the project;


C. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into such contracts and subcontracts as may be necessary to conduct the program.
